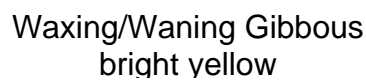
Waxing/Waning Crescent

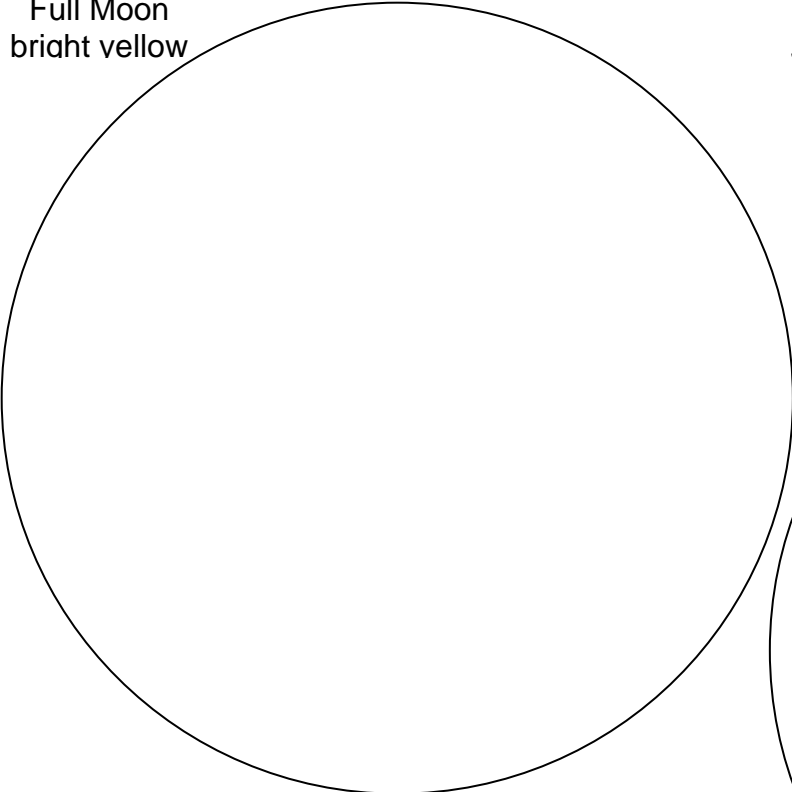


Waxing/Waning Gibbous
bright yellow

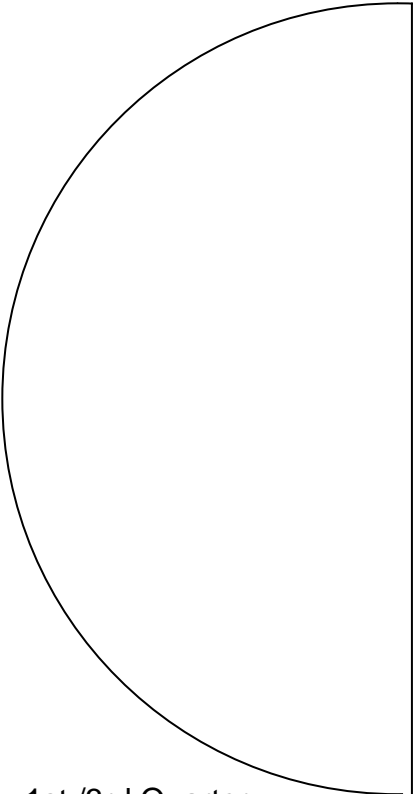
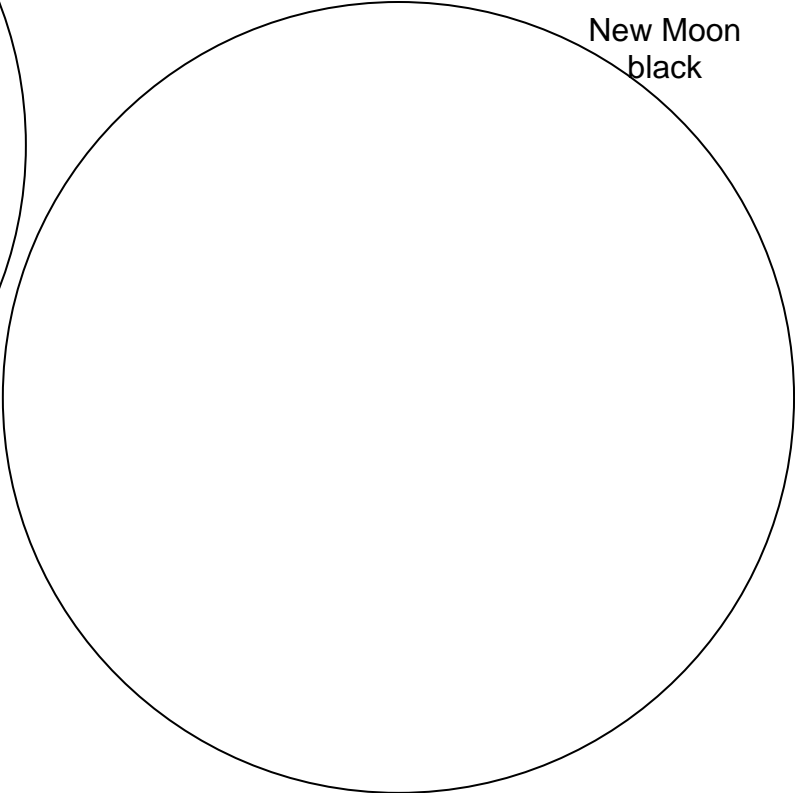


Stackable Moon Phases

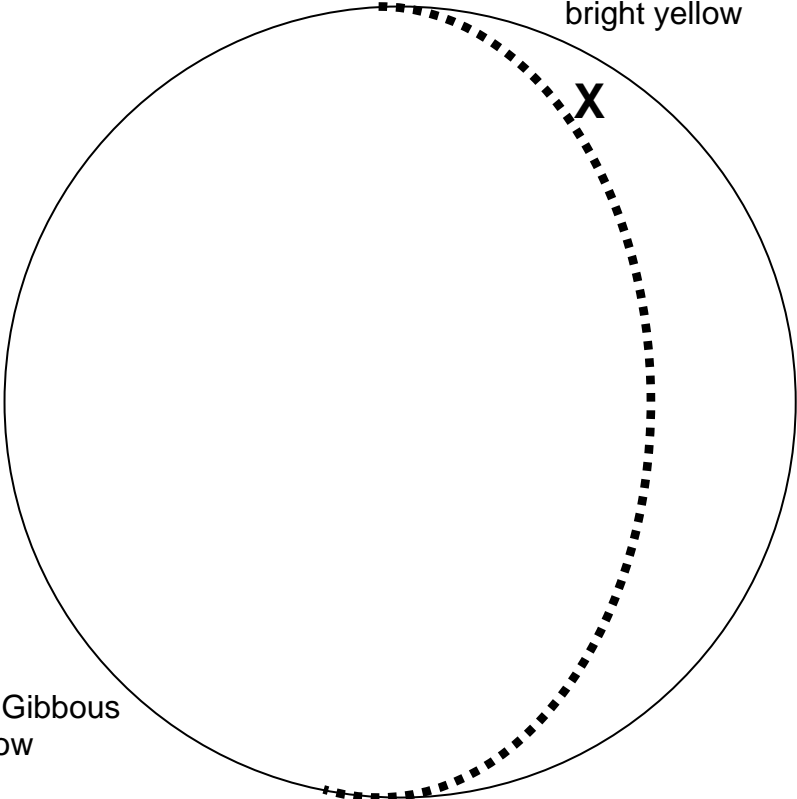

Materials needed per student:

- one moon phases cutout page
- scissors
- yellow and black crayon, if student will be coloring the blank pages

Procedure:

- Copy the moon phase page either in color or black/white
- Stack all the pieces in the following order.

- 1) black - new moon
- 2) yellow sliver - crescent
- 3) yellow half - quarter
- 4) yellow oblate - gibbous
- 5) yellow - full moon

Insert brad at X and push through all pieces. A hole punch with a small punch area will help.

With left hand, hold at the brad and with right hand, rotate the black circle to the top - this is NEW MOON phase.
