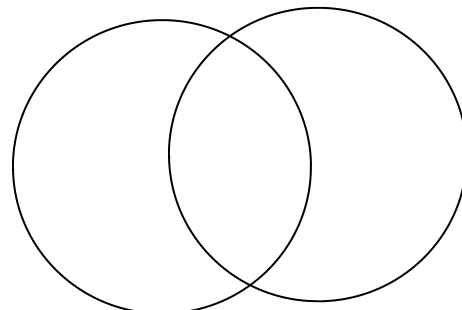


Graphic Organizer Suggestions

Foldables

Foldables are like 3-D graphic organizers. They are created by folding and cutting paper to make a graphic organizer for displaying information. They often have flaps that can be lifted to reveal information. Be creative!
